TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Penshurst Road, Leigh will be closed to through traffic, on or after 29th October 2024 for up to 4 days.

The road will be closed at Park Holt, Penshurst Road.

The alternative route is via Penshurst Road, B2176 Station Hill, B2176 Moorden Lane, B2027 Tonbridge Road, Penshurst Road, reverse.

This closure is necessary to enable water mains repairs to be carried out by South East Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
