## **ST PETERS ROW, FORDCOMBE**

### **TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

**Kent County Council gives notice that St Peters Row, Fordcombe will be closed to through traffic, on or after 30th October 2023 for up to 1 day.**

**The whole road will be closed.**

**There is no alternative route. Every effort will be made to maintain access for residents whenever it is safe to do so.**

**This closure is necessary to enable carriageway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.**

**This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.**
